Caring for a close relative in need of care

I attach the following:

- **Expert opinion issued by the Medical Review Board** (§ 3 para. 2 Caregiver leave law)
- **Proof for the degree of relationship** (§ 7 para. 3 Caregiver leave law)

Leave of absence

Leave of absence is granted ex officio upon application by April 1 for the summer semester and by October 20 for the winter semester.

Period of study abroad

Exemption is granted ex officio upon application if a period of study abroad is provided for in the study or examination regulations.

Completion of a practical semester

Exemption is granted ex officio upon application if a practical semester is provided for in the study or examination regulations.

To 2.: Waiver because of unreasonable hardship

A handicap or severe illness has prolonged the duration of study

I attach the following:

- **official medical certificate** (§ 14 para. 2 sentence 3 NHG)

Being a victim of a criminal offence has prolonged the duration of study

I attach the following:

- **Proof of damage to health within the meaning of § 1 of the Victim Compensation Act (e.g. court judgment)**
Further suitable proof can be decided after personal counselling at the Enrolment and Examination Office.

Re 3: Decree due to an epidemic situation or a disaster situation

- **Written explanation** as to why the situation has hindered progress in your studies and why the study period has been extended as a result
